

Catering

On the club grounds there is also the ATS club pub Corvus with a restaurant (not included in the catering fee).

Tournament rules:

The B and C junior teams play on a grass pitch for 9 players, the D junior teams play on a grass pitch for 7 players - all with off-side. The E juniors play on grass pitch for 7 players without off-side.

The players in the B teams must be U17 (aged 15 and 16), C teams must be U15

(13 and 14), D teams must be U13 (11 and 12), and the E teams must be U11 (9 and 10).

The final programme (grouping etc.) will be provided on time. It is subject to alteration depending on the level of registrations

Liability/Insurance:

The organiser is not liable for slight negligence (except in the case of damage resulting from injury to life, limb or health). Furthermore, all claims for damages by players against other players due to bodily injury or damage to health are also excluded in the case of slight negligence. The organiser does not grant any insurance cover for players, coaches and spectators.

Please note:

- Alcohol is prohibited for all players on the sports fields and campsites during the tournament.
- **Photographs and videos** will be taken on the grounds for documentation and publicity purposes. If you do not wish to be photographed, please contact the photographer.
- The use of **large speakers** is prohibited on the ATS Buntentor grounds for noise protection reasons. There is an adjacent beach...
