Saturday, 15 June 2024: Welcome speech at approximately 9 a.m.

Sunday, 16 June 2024: Tournament from appr. 9 a.m. to appr. 3 p.m.

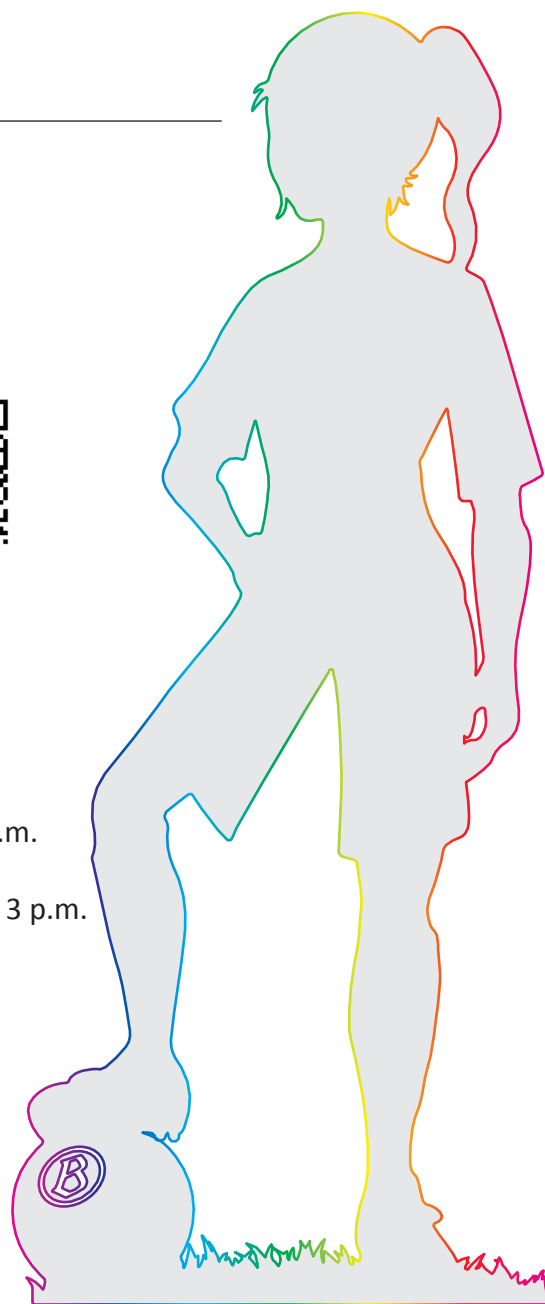
Tournament fee / Registration:

Please register by **01 April 2024**.
The entry fee per team is €50.
We charge an additional €25 per participant for:

- Two overnight stays
- Breakfast on Saturday and Sunday
- Lunch on Saturday
- and a reusable cup

For overnight stays outside the club grounds and without breakfast, the amount per participant is reduced to €15.

Please transfer the full amount (entry fee and food allowance) only after you have received the confirmation of participation.



Additional catering

On the club grounds there is also the ATS club pub Corvus with a restaurant (not included in the catering fee).

In addition to the standard catering (as described above), we offer grilled sausages and salads on Friday evening and a similar lunch on Sunday for 5 EUR per person.

Overnight stay:

In your own tents on our club grounds. If a group tent (space for 12 people) is required, we can provide this for an extra charge of €100.

Accommodation is also available in youth hostels and hostels in the vicinity of the sports grounds. Please do not hesitate to contact us if you have any questions.

Tournament rules:

The B and C juniors play on a 9-a-side pitch, the D and E juniors on a 7-a-side pitch.

The E-junior girls only play on Saturday, the award ceremony takes place on Saturday afternoon.

Eligible to play are:

- for the B teams the U17 age groups (aged 15 and 16)
- for the C teams the U15 age groups (aged 13 and 14)
- for the D teams the U13 age groups (aged 11 and 12)
- for the E teams the U11 age groups (aged 9 and 10).

The match schedule is subject to the number of registrations. The final tournament schedule will be made available to the coaches in good time.

Liability/Insurance:

The organiser is not liable for slight negligence (except in the case of damage resulting from injury to life, limb or health). Furthermore, all claims for damages by players against other players due to bodily injury or damage to health are also excluded in the case of slight negligence. The organiser does not grant any insurance cover for players, coaches and spectators.

Please note:

- **Alcohol is prohibited** for all players on the sports fields and campsites during the tournament.
- **Photographs and videos** will be taken on the grounds for documentation and publicity purposes. If you do not wish to be photographed, please contact the photographer.
- The use of **large speakers** is prohibited on the ATS Buntentor grounds for noise protection reasons. There is an adjacent beach...
- Please remember to bring **sunscreen** for the participants
