Sunday, June 29, 2025	Tournament from approximately 9:00 AM to 3:00 PM

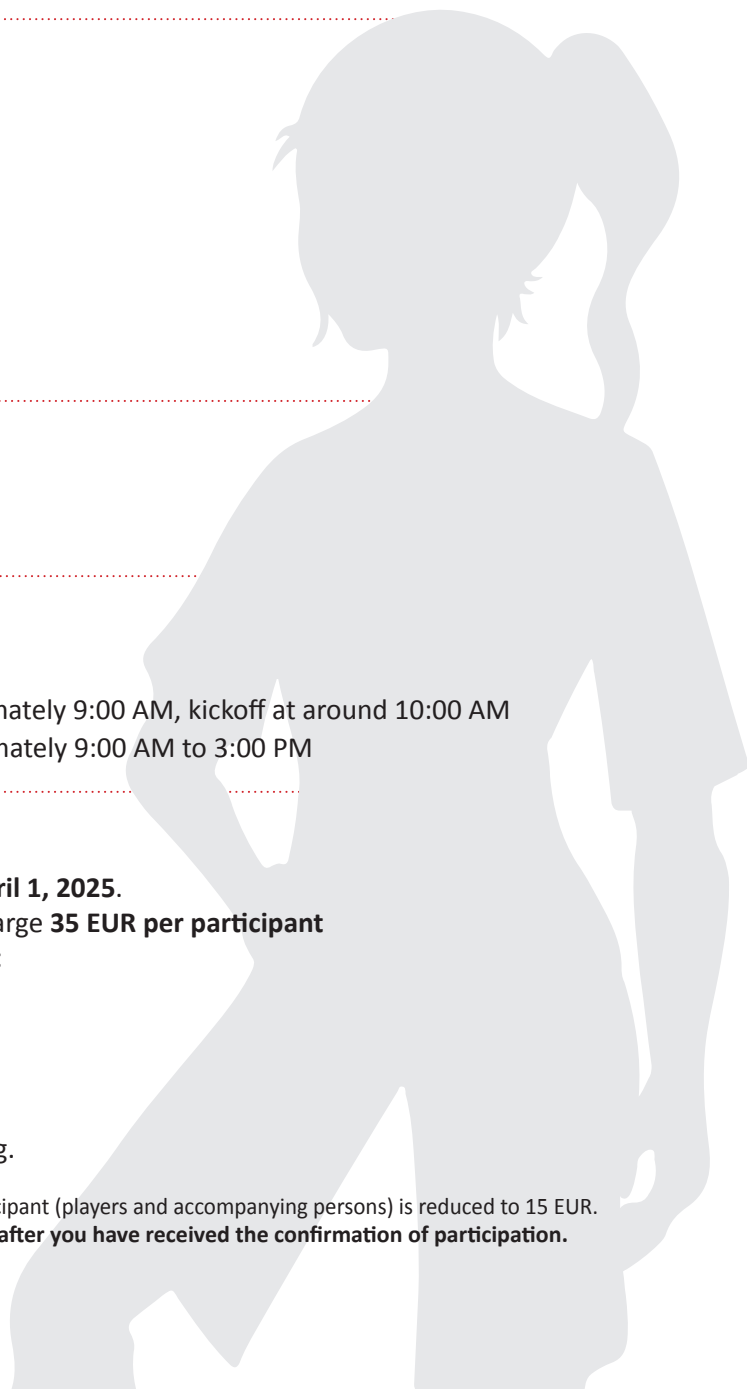
## Registration / Entry Fee

We kindly ask for a binding written **registration by April 1, 2025**.

The entry fee is **50 EUR per team**. Additionally, we charge **35 EUR per participant** (players and accompanying persons) for the following:

- Two overnight stays (in your own tents)
- Dinner on Friday
- Breakfast on Saturday and Sunday
- Lunch on Saturday and Sunday
- A basic supply of mineral water and a GirlsCup mug.

For off-site accommodation and without breakfast, the fee per participant (players and accompanying persons) is reduced to 15 EUR. **Please transfer the full amount (entry fee and catering fee) only after you have received the confirmation of participation.**



## Additional Catering

On Saturday evening, teams will arrange their own meals – for example, at Corvus, located directly on the club premises.

## Accommodation

You are welcome to set up your tents on the club grounds. Each team is allocated a limited amount of space – feel free to use group tents. Additionally, there are accommodation options in nearby youth hostels and hostels close to the sports grounds. Please note that it is not possible to sleep in vehicles on the premises. If you have any questions, feel free to reach out to us.

## Tournament Rules

The U17 (B) and U15 (C) teams will play on 9-a-side fields, while the U13 (D) and U11 (E) teams will play on 7-a-side fields. The U11 (E) teams will play only on Saturday, with the winners' ceremony taking place on Saturday afternoon. Eligibility:

- for the B-teams the age groups of the U17
- for the C-teams the age groups of the U15
- for the D-teams the age groups of the U13
- for the E-teams the age groups of the U11.

The match schedule is subject to the number of registrations. The final tournament format will be shared with coaches in advance and will also be available on our website.

## Liability/Insurance

The organizer's liability for simple negligence is excluded, except in cases of injury to life, body, or health. Additionally, claims for damages by players against other players due to bodily harm or health injuries in cases of simple negligence are excluded. The organizer does not provide insurance coverage for players, coaches, or spectators.
